## WHO IS MY NEIGHBOR?

Luke 10:25-37



This Sunday the Gospel is from St. Luke 10:25-37 and tells the parable of the good Samaritan.

This parable leaves no doubt about who our neighbor is — anyone who needs our help; nor about how we should love him — by taking pity on him, being compassionate towards his spiritual or corporal needs; and it is not just a matter of having the right feelings towards him: we must do something, we must generously serve him.

Christians, who should be disciples of Christ, should share his love and compassion, never distancing themselves from others' needs. One way to express love for one's neighbor is to perform the "works of mercy," which get their name from the fact that they are not duties in justice. 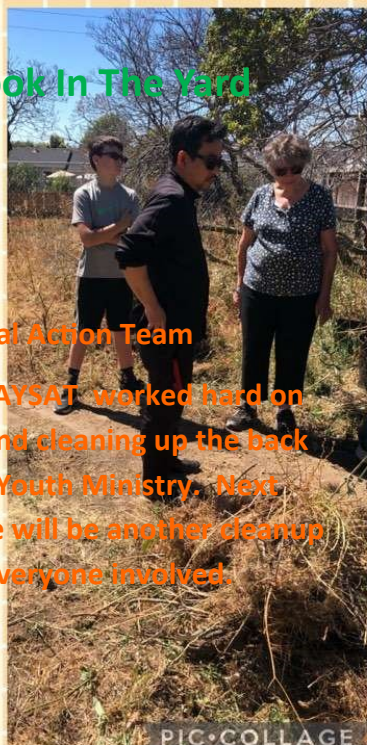


## New Improved Look In The Yard

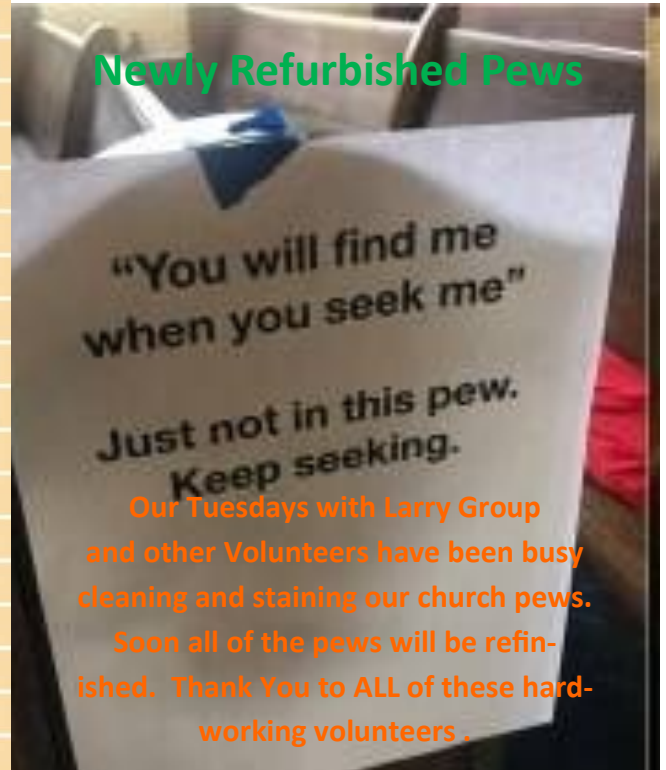


### Assumption Youth Social Action Team
