This weekend we will have a missionary from India speaking at all the masses telling us about his work in India and asking for our help. Please be generous.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Let me begin my mission appeal with a note of gratitude to your Pastor and each one of you for your generosity in supporting the mission of the Diocese of Kottapuram in India. Our Diocese comprises of 25000 families which means 100,000 catholic faithful.

Our diocese is blessed with good vocations. Currently, we have 106 priests in our diocese who are working in and around the world. We have 23 major seminarians who are studying philosophy and theology and 34 minor seminarians. Our major expenses are for the formation of the seminarians which come almost \$1200 for each seminarian per year and these huge expenses are met with the generous help which is rendered by people like you. Our mission is mainly carried out through our Social Service Department since our geographical area is largely coastal where people work in areas like fishing and other unorganized sectors like masonry, carpentry etc. They find it very much difficult to meet their livelihood and education of their children. The major thrust area of our Social Service Department is the empowerment of women, children, Differently Abled and Elderly. The burden of running all of these institutions falls on the shoulder of the diocese. I request your prayerful support and financial assistance to continue all the good works we do.

We have our great faith and confidence in you. What we can give you in return is our sincere prayers. Our people will remember you in their prayers.
