Diocese of Oakland Mission Alignment Process

The Catholic Church is the longest continually running institution in the world. She keeps herself relevant in every age because she is more than a human institution: she is also divine. It is the Holv Spirit that makes sure the Catholic Church is relevant in every age, and every age must look to her for inspiration and guidance. Recent declines in Mass attendance. baptisms, vocations to the priesthood and other factors are challenging us to take a fresh look at ourselves. In response, Bishop Michael Barber, S.J. is asking every Catholic in the Oakland diocese to support the Mission Alignment Process (MAP).

Guided by the Holy Spirit, this process will help us align our precious resources: our wonderful lay faithful, our parishes and schools, our clergy, and our financial resources for missionary fruition. Change is never easy, but when did God ever say that our lives would be easy? The way to salvation always has a cross in its path. But it is precisely the cross which leads us to new life.
