


### **The Introductory Rites**

you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

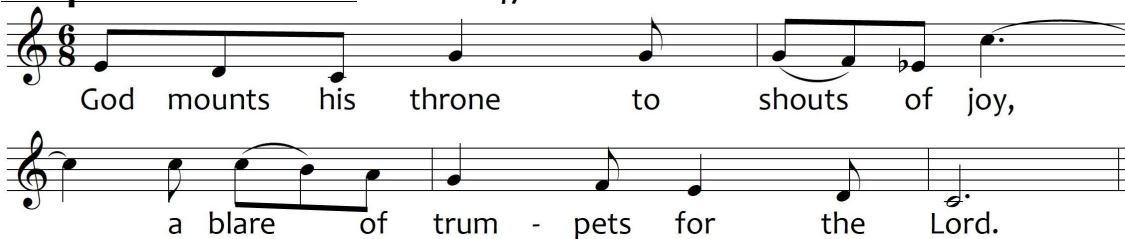
For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord,
