## Update on Church Audio Improvements

We are happy to announce that we are close to the installation of our improved sound system for the church. It has been a long process, and the efforts have been numerous and ongoing to get to this point.

This project was initiated in 2020, with more focused effort in 2021. Consultation on design and bids were secured, all in the uncertain time of COVID, when material sourcing was very spotty, at best. Bill Vaughn, Paul Jackman, Kelly Hodgins and Peter Gisslow were key in remaining focused on the proposed work, and diligently moving the process along.

The projected final cost is in the range of fifty five to sixty five thousand dollars for the new equipment and installation, which is significant. This includes steerable speakers for the altar area, a digital mixer and remote stagebox system, and a microphone system which include choir, handheld, head worn and gooseneck microphones. Significant electrical and cabling work will be required for the installation.

Most amazing and appreciated, is the financial support of Assumption parishioners to this project.To date, we have raised a total of 72,929.66 that is dedicated to the new sound system. (Please see Donation summary listed below). Generous support has been provided by an anonymous Sponsor who donated \$10,000, the Assumption Filipino Community which raised and donated over \$15,000 from the last two years' Simbang Gabi celebrations in the Christmas season, and over \$9,000 donated by the Assumption Knights of Columbus chapter from the recent Christmas raffle. Any funds collected that exceed the cost of the sound system install are being allocated to be used for church and facility needs. Your generosity has also allowed us to repair the four heater units in the church.

The sound system equipment has been purchased and is scheduled to begin arriving this week. We will coordinate installation once all of the material is on site, and will keep everyone updated as the process develops. We are very excited, and can't wait to turn on the new system! Soon we will hear the sweet sound of the Children's Choir.

We cannot express how appreciative we are for your support and generosity. Our most heartfelt thanks are expressed to all of you. Let us continue to pray for one another and our community. May God bless you and your loved ones.


